Personal Equipment List

- This list provides the equipment you will need for the first weekend camping in your personal tent. Please check your tent prior to our first weekend - to make sure you have everything you need i.e...Tent, stakes, poles, fly, and ground cloth. (We don't have a lot of extra supplies in the barn for 'forgotten' or lost items.) Please keep your tent foot print to 10' x 10', we have limited space in the campsites we are using.

The second weekend you will have an outdoor experience and additional equipment will be required. This information will be provided to you on the first weekend.

Required:

- Official Scout uniform(s) for your current scouting position. A complete uniform includes the official shirt, shorts, long pants, skirt, or culottes. Any type scouting sock and belt. Green applets. You may wear any scouting award knots. A neckerchief, slide and name badge will be provided. *Note: If you do not have Official BSA Pants for your current position please wear Green Docker Type Pants/shorts. NO JEANS.*
- Scout activity T-shirt. One is provided with course fees. Others may be ordered and purchased. Other activity T-shirts are acceptable. Non-scouting shirts are not acceptable.
- Shoes or boots
- Scout hat – optional. If worn, should be the course hat(s) and can be ordered and purchased.
- Windbreaker or jacket
- A small amount of money, there will be a collection at the Scouts Own Service on days 3 and 6. And a trading post.
- Rain gear (poncho or rain suit)
- Underwear
- Handkerchiefs
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Air mattress, Thermarest, pad or cot.
- Tent
- **Sleeping bag**

- Flashlight with spare batteries and bulb
- Pocketknife or multiple tool-type knife (no fixed blade knives)
- Medication in labeled containers
- Toiletries
- Towels and washcloths
- Pens, pencils and paper. You will be provided with a course notebook.
- Water bottle or canteen
- Handbook for your scouting program
- Camp chair and/or stadium cushion

Optional:

- Pillow
- Change of shoes
- Moccasins or camp slippers
- Shower footwear
- Sunglasses
- Religious book(s)
- Books of camp songs, skits, etc.
- Camera and film

Tips for summer/fall camping:

- Package of hand wipes for a refreshing wipe down
- Battery powered fan for a good night's sleep
