Personal Equipment List

This list provides the equipment you will need for the first weekend camping in your personal tent. Please check your tent prior to our first weekend - to make sure you have everything you need i.e...Tent, stakes, poles, fly, and ground cloth. (We don't have a lot of extra supplies in the barn for 'forgotten' or lost items.) Please keep your tent foot print to 10' x 10', we have limited space in the campsites we are using.

The second weekend you will have an outdoor experience and additional equipment will be required. This information will be provided to you on the first weekend.

Our course and activities continue hot or cold, rain or shine. Be Prepared!

Required:

- Official Scout uniform(s) for your current scouting position. A complete uniform includes the official shirt with shoulder loops, shorts, long pants, skirt, or culottes. Any type scouting sock and belt.. You may wear any scouting award knots. A neckerchief, slide, course hat and name badge will be provided. *NO JEANS*.
- Scout activity T-shirt. One is provided with course fees. Others may be ordered and purchased. Other Scouting activity T-shirts are acceptable. Non-scouting shirts are not acceptable.
- Shoes or boots (no open toed shoes)
- Windbreaker or jacket
- Rain gear (poncho or rain suit)
- Underwear
- Handkerchiefs
- Sleeping bag
- Air mattress, camp, pad or cot.
- Tent
- "Mess kit", utensils and mug, dunk bag. (Dishes, utensils. Etc. are not provided.)
- Water bottle or canteen
- Flashlight with spare batteries and bulb

- Pocketknife or multiple tool-type knife (no sheath knives per BSA policy)
- Medication in labeled containers
- Toiletries
- Towels and washcloths
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Pens, pencils and paper. You will be provided with a course notebook
- Handbook for your scouting program
- Camp chair and/or stadium cushion
- A small amount of money, there will be a collection at the Scouts Own Service on days 3 and 6.

Optional:

- Pillow
- Change of shoes
- Moccasins or camp slippers
- Shower footwear
- Sunglasses
- Religious book(s)
- Books of camp songs, skits, etc.
- Camera

Tips for summer/fall camping:

- Package of hand wipes for a refreshing wipe down
- Battery powered fan for a good night's sleep
